

Freeman Gardens Rental Guide

Thank you for your support! Please review the following rental information and feel free to reach out with any questions. We hope you have a great event and enjoy our beautiful garden!

Rental fees:

The Freeman Garden Association is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. There are considerable on-going maintenance costs to keep the grounds and roses in pristine condition for all to enjoy. 100% of the rental fee is a donation to Freeman Gardens and directly supports these efforts.

The following rates are available for events up to 5 hours plus time for set-up/clean-up. Same-day removal of all event items is required. An additional \$200 daily fee will be incurred if items are not removed from the garden same-day.

FEE:

\$250 (up to 50 people)

\$400 (50 to 100 people)

For larger scale events that include a tent and/or portajohn, the following rate includes an additional day for removal of all event items.

FEE:

\$1250 (up to 100 people)

Important information to keep in mind:

- *As this is a public garden, space for private events is available on a limited basis.*
- *We cannot reserve rain dates.*
- *100 person max for events.*
- *Event clean-up must be completed by 8pm.*
- *There is no large sink or kitchen for food prep.*
- *There is one bathroom (NOTE: access requires 2 stairs)*
- *No fire/open flames allowed on premises.*

Rental includes:

- (3) six-foot tables
- (1) four-foot table
- (29) white plastic chairs
- (12) white folding chairs
- Use of the bathroom - cleaned and stocked with toilet paper, soap, paper towels
- Patio set up - table with umbrella and (8) chairs
- Extension cords
- Garbage cans / liners
- Recycle bins
- Sprinkler and hose
- Fridge and freezer
- (2) large beverage bins

Please note:

- The Freeman Gardens Association is not responsible for any deliveries, pick-ups or set-ups.
- **NO PARKING or DRIVING on the garden driveway.** Loading and unloading needs to be done on the street. That includes any rental equipment trucks and deliveries.

Post-event clean-up:

- Garbage bags must be tied up.
- Garbage bags and recycling must be left inside the coop.
- Turn bathroom lights off and empty garbage.
- Turn off coop lights and close the door (pull down the chain to close).
- Lock and close the front gate.
- Please clean up the party before dark to ensure all garbage on the property is collected.

Garden rules:

To ensure the safety and wellbeing of ALL the living things in our garden, please keep the following rules in mind:

- **NO PARKING or DRIVING on the garden driveway.** Loading and unloading needs to be done on the street. That includes any rental equipment trucks and deliveries.
- No picking of flowers or walking through the flower beds.
- No climbing the trees or the coop roof.
- No hard alcohol.

- No confetti, glitter or nerf gun pellets.
- No fire/open flames.
- Ball playing on the main grass area only.
- Please monitor your children.
- We have bee hives and many bees on the property; please bring an EpiPen if you are allergic.
- Please clean-up after your event so our volunteers don't have to.
